

We are convinced that, for the preparation of our discussions it would be helpful to deal with official EU documents. In this connection we especially want to highlight the military and war dimension. Kees is completely right to orient us on that we want to share with you. Frieder and me also stressed this problem in the contribution newly put on the blog concerning industrial policy (see especially: European Commission, Communication from the Commission “Towards a more competitive and efficient defence and security sector”, COM 2013(542) final, 24.7.2013¹; European Commission, Commission staff working document on defence, accompanying the communication „Towards a more competitive and efficient defence and security sector”, COM 2013(542) final, 24.7.2013²; the SIPRI paper³).

The view on official material is also explained under “Discussion material” referring to the Commission paper “Did you know ...?”⁴ that attempts to marginalize the military and war issues. The Commission Communication announced there on page 15 has already already been published and doesn’t fulfill to its own promise. So the securisation issue has been totally marginalized . Still, the paper to the G20 Summit and also the official “EU response to the crisis”⁵ are helpful to discuss the issues on

- Policy priorities
- Causes of the crisis and crisis effects
- Links between the global financial and economic crisis and the global social and environmental crisis – i.e the global reproduction crisis
- The new stage of neo-liberal transformation of the EU
- Criteria for “good” and “successful” policies and therefore also for left alternative conceptions and strategies.

For highlighting these problems we shall also put some further statistical materials on the blog.
